Looking Towards Church Opening

What will church look like in the new normal of the Coronavirus? The consistory has begun the reopening planning process. The points below will begin to give you a new picture of what it may look like when we gather back together. These points are preliminary.

- Everyone will need to practice the six-foot social distancing standard
- Masks will be worn by staff and consistory
- Members are encouraged to wear masks
- Bulletins will be stacked by the doors for self-serve
- Seats will be spaced out to make it easier for social distancing
- Offering tables inside the Sanctuary (no plates will be passed)
- Chocolate stations will be available for self-serve (no plates will be passed)
- No more black books for attendance
- Nursery will be open as a cry room for parents (no staff or volunteers)
- No Children's Church will be available (opening will be planned at a later date)
- Family Worship will be in place of Children's Church
- Video recording equipment will be set up in the Sanctuary


LBC Food Truck Moves Outdoors
