We invite people to connect with Jesus and with each other in all that we do.

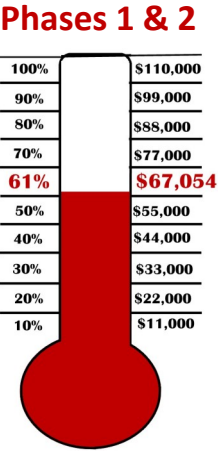
