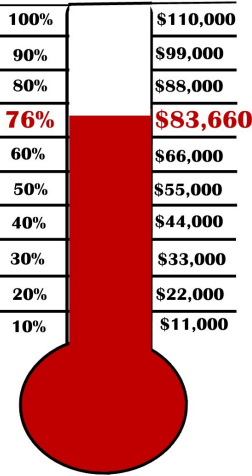
Raise the Roof Campaign
