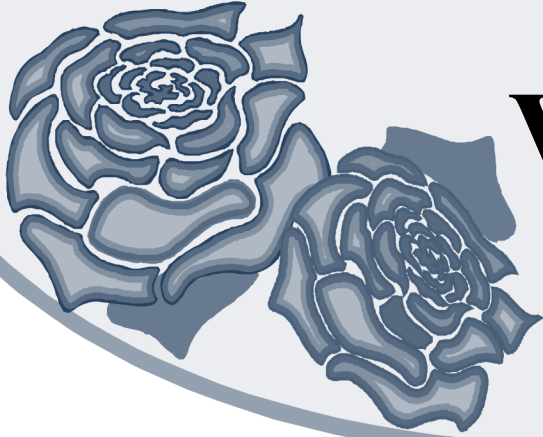


Laketon Bethel Youth Group
