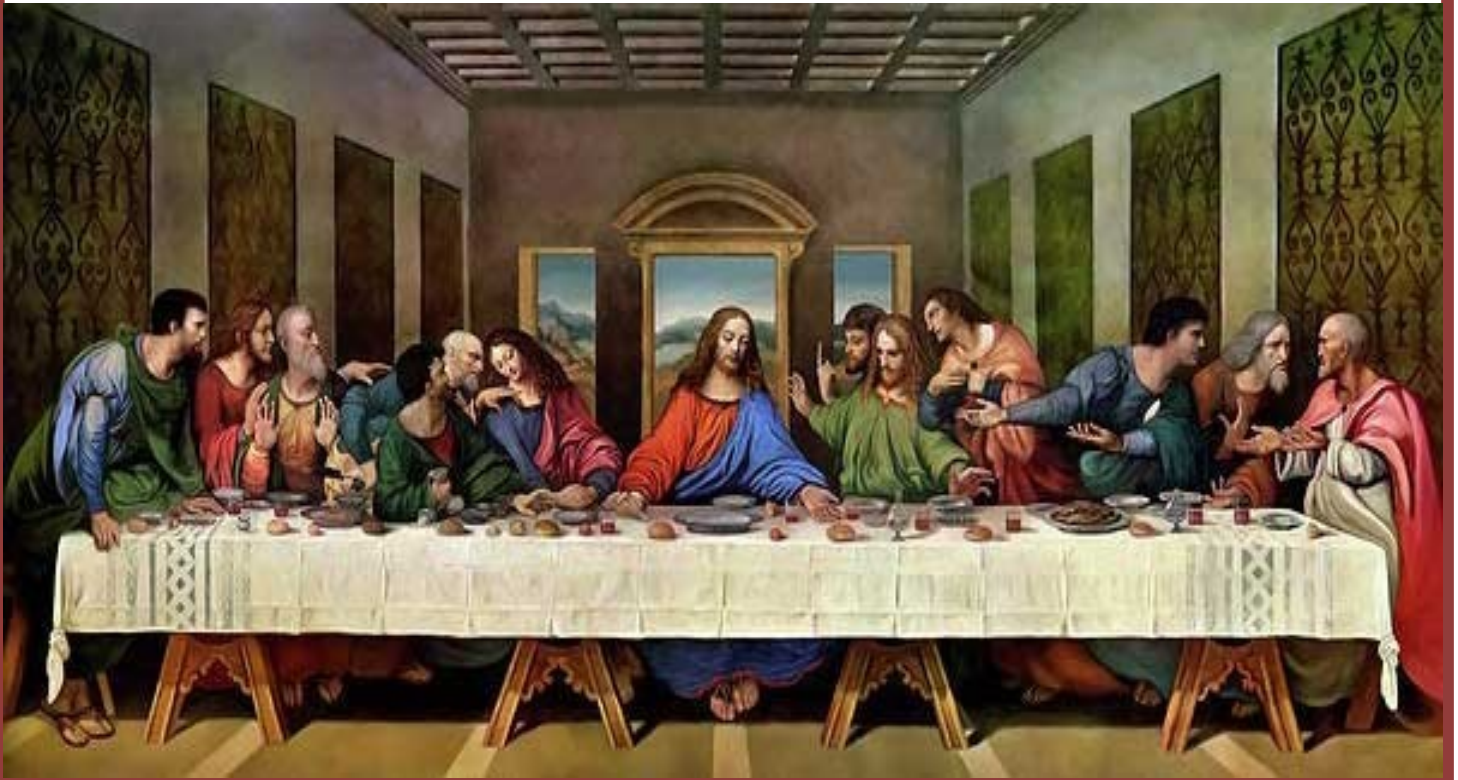

Big Idea:

Jesus has power over the misery caused by self-pity and bad habits. He will walk with you and help you change your bad attitudes to attitudes of gratitude, which will make all the difference in your life.

A bad attitude is not a demon, but it is the horse a demon rides in on. A bad attitude is like exposing your skin to mosquitos, handling snakes or playing with fire. Eventually, you feel the demonic burn.

Questions for your consideration:

Does positive thinking make any real difference in life?

Why did Mark include this story about the demonic pigs in his gospel?

What is a good thing to do with your bad attitudes?

How can we apply this passage to our celebrations of Christmas?
